# **School Opening Times**

### **Nut Allergy**

A number of pupils enrolled in our school have a medical diagnosis of anaphylaxis. This allergic reaction (anaphylactic shock) can occur through ingestion of nuts/peanuts/nut products, cross contamination or occasionally through breathing nuts in the air.

- Avoiding giving your school-going children nuts/ peanuts in school lunches.
- Avoiding giving peanut butter sandwiches, other spreads containing nuts such as "Nutella" and snacks/bars containing nuts or labelled "may contain nut traces" in school lunches.
- Asking your children not to share their school lunches.

Due to the severity of the problem, it is important that all parents fully co-operate with the suggested

measures and help reduce the risks of allergic reaction to these pupils.

#### **Head Lice**

Parents are encouraged to regularly check their child's hair for signs of head lice. Your pharmacist will advise you on the treatment options available.
